FIRE EMERGENCY

When fire is discovered:

- Alert bystanders to evacuate area
- Notify the local Fire Department by calling <u>999</u>
- Notify the site personnel about the fire emergency by the following means:

Voice Communication Phone 07970 857696 OR 07885 440728 **Evacuation routes:**

- EAST towards Charmouth and grey cliffs
- WEST towards Lyme Regis town

Refuge points:

• along sea wall

If not available

• use either direction

Fire Extinguishers / fighting equipment:

- All vendors to carry fire fighting equipment suitable to their needs
- Fire blanket the The Salty Arms bar

Only use fire fighting equipment if trained to do so

Fire Alarms

- Gas sounder alarm located at the bar
- Trader outlets to have means of alerting public (voice) and emergency co-ordinator (mobile phone)
- Person identifying the fire should call 999 or, if unable to do so, alert the co-ordinator.

Assembly Points

- Staff and trader assembly point Clocktower in Cobb Gate car park
- General public will be advised to leave the area and assemble on the south west coast path OR Cobb Car park OR promenade

Fight the fire ONLY if:

- The Fire Department has been notified.
- The fire is small and is not spreading to other areas.
- Escaping the area is possible by backing up to the nearest exit.
- The fire extinguisher is in working condition and personnel are trained to use it.

Upon being notified about the fire emergency, occupants must:

- Leave the area using the designated escape routes.
- Assemble in the designated area (specify location): <u>Cobb Gate</u>
 <u>Car Park</u>
- Remain outside until the competent authority (Designated Official or designee) announces that it is safe to reenter.

Designated Official, Emergency Coordinator or supervisors must (underline one):

- Disconnect utilities and equipment unless doing so jeopardizes his/ her safety.
- <u>Coordinate an orderly evacuation of personnel.</u>
- Perform an accurate head count of employees reported to the designated area.
- Determine a rescue method to locate missing personnel.
- Provide the Fire Department personnel with the necessary information about the facility.
- Perform assessment and coordinate weather forecast office emergency closing procedures

Area/Floor Monitors must:

- Ensure that all employees have evacuated the area/floor.
- Report any problems to the Emergency Coordinator at the assembly area.

Assistants to Physically Challenged should:

 Assist all physically challenged employees and patrons in emergency evacuation.
